Tournament Rules & Golf Rules

Play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf 2023 and Local rules of Legend Danang Golf Resort (on the scorecard).

Tournament Format: Individual Gross & Net Stroke Play & System 36.

• A, B & C Division: Net Stroke Play (cut -4)

The official Handicap will be converted from Handicap Index updated on 01 June 2025 to the Handicap of Legend Danang Golf Resort. Golfers must check their Handicap on scorecard when check-in, all complaints must be resolved before playing.

- D, E & Ladies Divisions: System 36.
- NO "GIMMIES" ALL PUTTS MUST BE HOLED OUT ON EACH HOLE.

Assistance: Rule 10-2b(4)

A player must not make a stroke with his caddy, his partners or his partners caddy positioned on or close to an extension of the line of play or line of putt behind the ball. Penalty 02 Strokes.





Signing and Returning Scorecard: Rule 3-3b

- All players must exchange scorecards with their playing partners for marking scores. Completed scorecards must be submitted to the scoring table at the completion of the round. All players are requested to sign on scorecard list when submitting.
- Scorecards must be completed with gross scores of each hole. Incomplete scorecards and cards marked with + and par will not be accepted.
- Any protests must be lodged at the scoring table before handing in your scorecard. Once submitted, any changes will not be accepted. Failure to follow scorecard rules will result in disqualification.

Distance Measuring Devices 4-3

During the stipulated round, the use of a distance measuring device is allowed. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, a player uses a distance measuring device that may gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play, the player is in breach of Rule 4-3, penalty disqualification.

Ties

In the event of a tie in each division and overall, the player with the lowest handicap will be declared winner. If still tied, matching cards will determine the winner based on the best *GROSS* score counting back from the 18th hole and continue back until a winner is declared.

Suspension of Play due to Dangerous Situation: Rule 5-7

When play is suspended by the Committee for a dangerous situation, if the players in a match or group are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If they are in the process of playing a hole, they must discontinue play immediately and not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If a player fails to discontinue play immediately, he is disqualified.

DISCONTINUE PLAY IMMEDIATELY: ONE PROLONGED NOTE OF SIREN.

RESUME PLAY: TWO SHORT NOTES OF SIREN, REPEATED.

Disputes and Doubtful Points

Any dispute or doubtful point on the Rules shall be referred to the Tournament Committee as soon as possible on completion of the round and in any case not later than 15 minutes after completing the round.

Decisions

In the absence of a referee, any dispute or doubtful point on the Rules shall be referred to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final (Rule 20-2b).





Holes Not Played or Not Played Under the Rules of Handicapping 3-2

If a player does not play a hole or plays it other than under the Rules of Golf, the score recorded for that hole for handicap purposes must be:

- Division A, B, C: par plus any handicap strokes the player is entitled to receive on that hole. This hole score, when recorded, should be preceded by an "X." Example: A player with a Course Handicap of 10 receives a handicap stroke on the first 10 allocated handicap-stroke holes. If the player does not play the sixth allocated handicap-stroke hole, which is a par 4, the player must record a score of par plus one for handicap purposes, or X-5.
- Division D, E, Ladies: All holes not played will be scored with a Par.

Caddie

Caddie is not allowed to write on the scorecard and is responsible for signing the final scorecard as a 3rd party validator after finishing the game. Each player will have 01 caddie in the competition.

Prizes

Each golfer can only receive 01 Gross or Net prize. Each golfer can also win multiple Novelty Prizes, i.e. Near Pin, Long Drive.
